# **Emergency Communications Procedures for School Sites**

Emergency situations differ both in description and intensity. What they share in common, however, is the need to communicate quickly and effectively in order to protect the safety and welfare of students and staff, bring the emergency situation under control and communicate with all other appropriate parties.

# STEPS FOR SCHOOL SITES TO REPORT AN EMERGENCY INVOLVING A THREAT TO PHYSICAL SAFETY:

(Includes major earthquake, fire, bomb threat, suspicious package on site, major gas leak or electrical failure that creates a danger, major flooding, exposure to toxic material(s), explosion, major accident on or adjacent to campus, civil disturbance, criminal or other hostile behavior on campus that could affect personal safety.)

- 1. Call 911 and state the following: "This is an emergency."
  - Provide the following information:
    - The nature of the emergency
    - Your name and position (e.g. "I am the principal at ...")
    - Your school site (include the street address)
    - Phone number where you can be reached after this call (preferably a mobile phone)
  - Do not hang up until you are sure no further information is required, unless there
    is an immediate threat to your own safety.
- **2.** Call the District Office (619-336-7700) *IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER* to report the emergency, steps taken thus far and to coordinate further steps.
- 3. Follow existing emergency response procedures.
- 4. Refer news media calls immediately to the District Office (619-336-7700).
- **5. When children are not (or no longer) in danger**, assure parents, other primary caregivers that their children are safe and not (or no longer) in any physical danger.
  - As appropriate, emphasize to parents and others that the physical and emotional well being of every student is the number-one priority for every school in the National School District.
